

## **Fall Ball 2023**

(all practices held at Moreland Little League Fields, 4660 Eastus Dr.)

The Fall Ball season will operate from September 11th through October 30th for a total of 8 weeks.

### **What is different about Fall Ball?**

Fall Ball is a developmental baseball program where:

- \* No official score is kept nor official records.
- \* Players can play for whatever league they would like, no matter where they live as Little League boundaries do not apply.
- \* It is common for players to play a division higher than regular season since this is mainly about skills coaching to improve player ability. It is also a great way for new players to be introduced to baseball or for returning players to hone their skills at a higher level.
- \* Upper Division Teams will play against other Fall Ball leagues in the area. Local travel may be required.
- \* one practice per week and optional scrimmages or games on Saturdays. Additional team practices for upper divisions as specified by team coaches. Upper Division games at other leagues on Sundays.

### **Would you like to help out?**

As always, we need the help of volunteers to make the fall season successful. Families might be called upon to help set-up and break down the fields before/after practices and games. We are also in need of parent volunteers to help coach the teams. We are always on the lookout for parents who want to get involved and help our players get better. If you've never coached or assisted before, fall ball is a great way to dip your toes in the coaching waters. There is a low pressure atmosphere, and tons of support. ### **Tee Ball - League age 4-5**

(hit off the tee, try coach pitch, no outs counted)

Each practice should be FUN with the goal of tricking the kids into learning baseball skills without the pressure of baseball. Parents are asked to be present, to participate by guiding their player as needed or to assist the coach.

### **A-Ball - League age 5-6**

\$180

(hit off the tee and coach pitch)

Each practice should be FUN with the goal of tricking the kids into learning baseball skills without the pressure of baseball. Parent volunteers participate by assisting the coach.

### **AA-Ball - League age 7-8**

\$180

(coach pitch, introduction of player pitch)

### **Minors - League age 8-12**

\$180

(player pitch only)

### **Majors - League age 10 - 12**

\$180

(player pitch only)

Advanced level of play.
